Gross Weight = 1,320 pounds (600 kilograms)

Floatplanes = 1,430 (650 kilograms)

Max. Full Power Speed = 120 knots (138 mph)

Stall Speed = 45 knots (52 mph) no more dual stall speeds.

Fixed Prop – May be ground adjustable.

Fixed Gear – Amphibians allowed “reposition able” gear.

Two Place – Pilot and one passenger.
